### \*CONFESSION OF FAITH *Heidelberg Catechism* (Questions 16-19)

One: Why must the mediator be a true and righteous human?

**Many: God's justice demands that human nature, which has sinned, must pay for sin; but a sinful human could never pay for others.**

One: Why must the mediator also be true God?

**Many: So that the mediator, by the power of his divinity, might bear the weight of God's wrath in his humanity and earn for us and restore to us righteousness and life.**

One: Then who is this mediator — true God and at the same time a true and righteous human?

**Many: Our Lord Jesus Christ, who was given to us to completely deliver us and make us right with God.**

One: How do you come to know this?

**Many: The holy gospel tells me. God began to reveal the gospel already in Paradise; later God proclaimed it by the holy patriarchs and prophets and foreshadowed it by the sacrifices and other ceremonies of the law; and finally God fulfilled it through his own beloved Son.**
