## PRELUDE

### PRAYER OF PREPARATION FOR WORSHIP

*(for silent prayer during the prelude)*

O God, glorious and faithful, to those who seek you with a sincere heart you reveal the beauty of your face. Strengthen us in faith to embrace the mystery of the cross, and open our hearts to its transfiguring power; that, clinging in love to your will for us, we may walk the path of discipleship as followers of your Son, Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever.<sup>1</sup> Amen.

### ANNOUNCEMENTS AND GREETING

#### \*CALL TO WORSHIP (BASED ON PSALM 50)

One: Our God comes and does not keep silence, before him is a devouring fire, and a mighty tempest all around him.

All: **He calls to the heavens above and to the earth, that he may judge his people:**

One: "Gather to me my faithful ones, who made a covenant with me by sacrifice!"

All: **The heavens declare his righteousness, for God himself is judge. Let us worship God!**

#### HYMN OF PRAISE: "Immortal, Invisible, God Only Wise" #263

Immortal, invisible, God only wise, In light inaccessible hid from our eyes, Most blessed, most glorious, the Ancient of Days, Almighty, victorious, Thy great name we praise.

Unresting, unhasting, and silent as light, Nor wanting, nor wasting, Thou rulest in might; Thy justice like mountains high soaring above Thy clouds, which are fountains of goodness and love.

To all, life Thou givest, to both great and small; In all life Thou livest, the true life of all; We blossom and flourish like leaves on the tree, Then wither and perish; but naught changeth Thee.

Thou reignest in glory, Thou rulest in light, Thine angels adore Thee, all veiling their sight; All praise we would render; O help us to see 'Tis only the splendor of light hideth Thee!

#### \*CALL TO CONFESSION

In our Gospel passage, Peter, the disciple, is terrified and doesn't know what to say. He speaks out without thinking. We, likewise, can be quick to speak and to act, and we fail to discern God's will and to pay attention to God's work. Let us confess our sin.

#### \*SILENT PRAYER OF CONFESSION

#### \*CORPORATE PRAYER OF CONFESSION

**God of compassion, in Jesus Christ you reveal the light of your glory, but we turn away, distracted by our own plans. We confess that we speak when we should listen, and act when we should wait. Forgive our aimless enthusiasms. Grant us wisdom to live in your light and to follow in the way of your beloved Son, Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior.<sup>ii</sup> Amen.**

#### \*ASSURANCE OF PARDON

Later in Peter's time with Jesus, he denies Jesus three times as Jesus stands trial. This is not the end of the story, though. After Jesus is raised from the dead, he finds Peter and confirms his call to Peter three times, "Feed my lambs.... Tend my sheep.... Feed my sheep...". Despite that we all have sinned, Jesus can still use us. Heed his call, follow him, and know that you are forgiven. Amen.

#### \*CONFESSION OF FAITH *Heidelberg Catechism* (Question 86-87)

Many: **Because Christ, having redeemed us by his blood, is also restoring us by his Spirit into his image, so that with our whole lives we may show that we are thankful to God for his benefits, so that he may be praised through us, so that we may be assured of our faith by its fruits, and so that by our godly living our neighbors may be won over to Christ.**

One: Can those be saved who do not turn to God from their ungrateful and unrepentant ways?

Many: **By no means. Scripture tells us that no unchaste person, no idolater, adulterer, thief, no covetous person, no drunkard, slanderer, robber, or the like will inherit the kingdom of God.**

Almighty and loving God, despite that the "god" of this world works to blind the minds of those who do not believe, you are defeating that "god" more and more every day.  your gift off at the church.

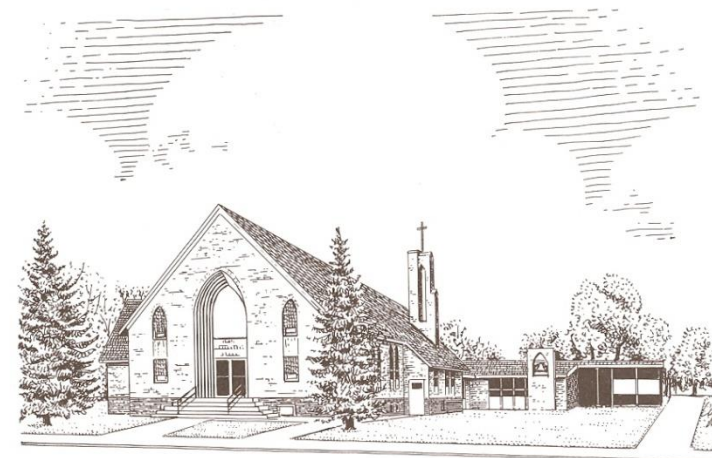
Come join us for **Ash Wednesday Worship, February 17<sup>th</sup> at**
