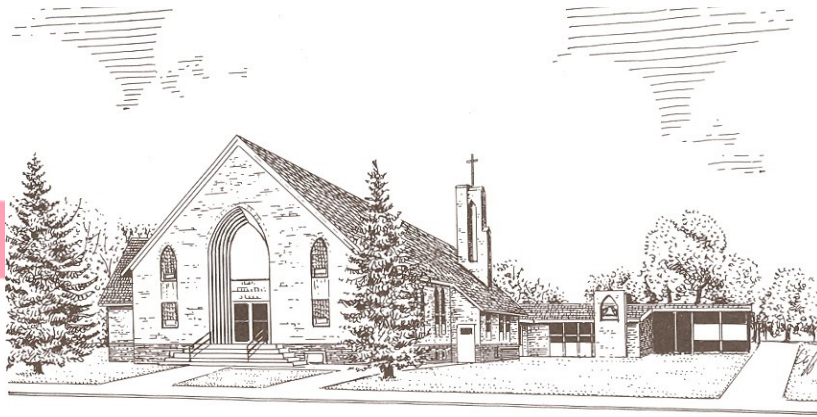

In the coming weeks we ask that you give prayerful thought as to how you can contribute to the new roof. This newsletter has several ideas of ways to help.



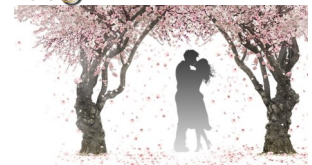
